Looking to get a jump-start on the intense M2 motorcycle course (DRIV-9025)? Planning on buying a motorcycle but never ridden one? Want to find out if the riding lifestyle is for you?

Check this out!

Introduction to Motorcycling is a three-hour course where you will learn how to properly balance and start a motorcycle, basic clutch control and bring the bike to a stop in a straight line. Learn from experienced instructors on Fanshawe supplied motorcycles.

Pre-requisites

Students **MUST** provide a D.O.T. approved helmet with shield or eye protection, long sleeved substantial jacket, leather gloves (cover fingers), long pants, low heeled over the ankle leather boots. Dress for the weather (rain gear, waterproof boots, etc.) as this course will run rain or shine.

Running shoes are NOT allowed. An M1 licence is NOT required.

Students will be required to sign a waiver at the beginning of the course. If a student is under the age of 18, a parent or legal guardian must attend the first 1/2 hour of the course to co-sign the course waiver. Please contact the College if you require further information.

Course Format

Sessions are held on one evening:

- Monday evening from 5:30pm-9pm
- Saturday evening from 4:00pm-7:30pm

Course Fee

The cost of this course is \$98.50 + HST. Refunds are only available until one week prior to the course start.

M2 Licence DRIV-9025

Learn to ride a motorcycle the right way! Fanshawe College offers this course in coordination with the Canada Safety Council. Our experienced, certified instructors will teach you basic riding concepts and skills necessary for safe handling of the motorcycle on the road. You will practice techniques such as balancing the motorcycle, the correct use of brakes, proper clutch control and gear changes. Learn to ride a motorcycle in a safe environment supervised by our professional training team. Motorcycles are provided by the college.

Learn From The Best

As part of your in-class study, you will receive a Canada Safety Council student kit which includes the Canada Safety Council's Motorcycle Rider's Handbook. The practical portion of the course is done on the College's training grounds. You will be provided with quality step by step instruction from our certified instructors on successful handling of a motorcycle.

Ensure safe riding techniques by learning defensive riding strategies and risk awareness skills.

Obtain An M2 Licence

At the end of the course, you will be tested by our staff licenced by the MTO, and if successful, will receive your M2 licence. Even though this test is challenging, we have an exceptional success rate.

Pre-requisites

It is mandatory to obtain an M1 licence from the Ministry of Transportation prior to taking this course. Students **MUST** provide a D.O.T. approved helmet with shield or eye protection, long sleeved substantial jacket, leather gloves (cover fingers), long pants, low heeled over the ankle leather boots. Dress for the weather (rain gear, waterproof boots, etc.) as this course will run rain or shine. **Running shoes are not allowed.**

Students will be required to sign a waiver at the beginning of the course. If a student is under the age of 18, a parent or legal guardian must attend the first 1/2 hour of the first session to co-sign the course waiver. Please contact the College if you require further information.

Course Format

Courses are available in three formats. Although each course provides the same number of training hours, the weekend and weekday formats require very long hours of riding.

One Weekend (three class format)

- Thursday evening from 6pm-9pm
- Saturday and Sunday from 8am-6pm

Two Weeks (week nights, six class format)

- Week 1 Monday thru Wednesday evenings from 5:30pm-9pm
- Week 2 Monday thru Wednesday evenings from 5:30pm-9pm

Weekdays (three days)

• Monday thru Wednesday from 8:30am-4:30pm

Prepare For The Test... Take The Test

Discover and correct bad riding habits you don't even know you have. Our instructors will guide you through in-class theory, practice range riding, and plenty of road course riding. Weaknesses in technique are quickly identified and corrected. You will build confidence by participating in a mock test prior to taking the exam.

At the end of the training program, our senior staff, authorized by the MTO, will administer the Class "M" road test (M2 Exit). The M2 Exit Training and Test for Motorcyclists course is offered in cooperation with the Canada Safety Council.

Pre-requisites

Students must have their own motorcycle with proof of valid insurance, ownership and a valid M2 licence. They also must have held the M2 for a period of more than 18 months with successful completion of Motorcycle Driver Education (22 months without Driver Education).

Students **MUST** provide a D.O.T. approved helmet with shield or eye protection, long sleeved substantial jacket, leather gloves (cover fingers), long pants, low heeled over the ankle leather boots. Dress for the weather (rain gear, waterproof boots, etc.) as this course will run rain or shine. **Running shoes are not allowed.**

Students will be required to sign a waiver at the beginning of the course. If a student is under the age of 18, a parent or legal guardian must attend the first 1/2 hour of the first session to co-sign the course waiver. Please contact the College if you require further information.

Course Format

Sessions are held over one weekend (two classes + test).

- Thursday evening from 5:30pm-9pm Saturday and Sunday 8am start
- On Sunday you will have a one hour test scheduled.

Course Fee
