TITLE: HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

THE POLICY:

- 1. The President is accountable for the health and safety performance of the College. In this regard, the President shall not fail to have in place a health and safety policy and related corporate health and safety management system including administrative and academic processes that demonstrate
 - 1.1. commitment to maintain a safe and healthy learning, living, working and playing environment;
 - 1.2. compliance with applicable legislation and regulations;
 - 1.3. identification of hazards and roles and responsibilities;
 - 1.4. awareness and training, risk mitigation and incident management; and
 - 1.5. leadership towards the implementation of current best practices including prevention of illnesses and injuries.

MONITORING:

- 1. The President shall present to the Board annually a monitoring report, which demonstrates compliance with this policy.
- 2. The President shall not fail to present to the Board any significant health and safety matters in a timely and accurate manner.

DIRECTION TO THE BOARD:

The Board will arrange for an independent audit of the College's health and safety policy and related corporate health and safety management system at least once every five years.
