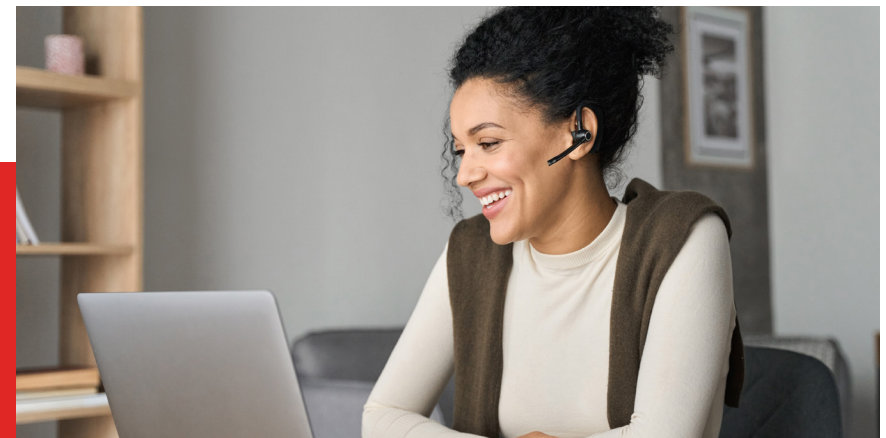

American Sign Language 101

Sep 20 - Nov 22 | Tue 6 - 9 p.m. | Online

This introductory course is designed for the student with no previous knowledge of American Sign Language (ASL) or with limited basic competencies. Students learn to handle basic everyday communication ASL incorporating Deaf culture and Deaf Community content. Topics centre on getting to know you, exchanging personal information, and discussing living situation. Grammar is introduced in context with an emphasis on developing question and answer skills.

American Sign Language 102

Sep 22 - Nov 24 | Thu 6 - 9 p.m. | In-class

The purpose of the second course in American Sign Language is to further the student's abilities in refining the skills learned/retained in ASL 101. The student learns to handle talking about Family, talking about activities and storytelling. Grammar is introduced in context with an emphasis on using question and answer skills, directions, and descriptions. Cultural notes and videotapes provide information on Deaf Culture and Deaf Community.

Artistic Welding
