



INVENTORY METHODOLOGY

The inventory was collected using the Survey123 app by ArcGIS. Each building was photographed and inventory entries were completed according to municipal address using City of St. Thomas CityMap information and base data from the Survey123 program. For each property the same details were recorded, including: municipal address, building height, building type, public/private domain, construction date/period, and architectural style. Details regarding the materials or architectural features were also recorded, including: foundation type (if visible), exterior cladding, roof type, number of window/door openings across the façade, window and door types, and other notable features.

The purpose of the inventory is to collect data in the Study Phase that helps to identify patterns for the study area as a whole. It is not intended to be a record of what can or cannot be changed on a given property, should the plan phase be undertaken. The inventory is meant to identify properties that contribute to an HCD character, and those that do not. In the plan phase, separate types of guidelines may be prepared for contributing and non-contributing properties, recognizing that the two property types have different physical features and maintenance needs.

Each property was classified as either contributing or non-contributing based on a visual assessment from the site visit and inventory form. The visual assessment took into consideration the integrity of heritage fabric of the property (its design/physical value) and/or its contextual relationship to the surrounding area. This classification contributes to an understanding of the study area as a whole, helping to identify whether there is a concentration of contributing properties.

For the purposes of this report, the definitions of "contributing" and "non-contributing" properties are as follows:

- Contributing properties are those that directly support the Statement of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest and heritage attributes of the HCD, as identified in the body of the repot, or are of a historical character. These properties were constructed between the 1870s and 1930s, either as part of the commercial core or railway industry, and retain historic building fabric or heritage features that distinguish them as older buildings of a particular era, type, or place.
- Non-contributing properties are those that do not directly support the Statement of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest and heritage attributes of the HCD. These properties may have been constructed more recently, and are not of historical character, or may be older properties that have been modified such that historic building fabric or detailing has been substantially altered, removed, or obscured. This also includes parking areas and vacant lots. Some older buildings outside of the recommended boundary have also been identified as 'non-contributing'. This means that they may contribute to the broader heritage character of St. Thomas, but are of a different character than identified in the Statement of Cultural Heritage



Value or Interest for the study area itself. Some of these properties may be candidates for further study to consider listing on the municipal registry, individual designation, or for inclusion in future HCD study areas.
