There are no hard prerequisites, but here are some recommendations/guidelines to make things go smoother.

Due note: the following courses are also available in the Fall term:

MGMT-6056, MGMT-6058, MGMT-6054, COMM-6019 (winter as well), MGMT-6062

Note, that these rules may contradict each other. They are only guidelines.

- Layout your entire course sequence before you start the program to ensure you don't get caught "waiting for courses to be offered"
- If you find business math quite challenging, take 6056 & 6058 in different semesters, these courses are offered in Fall and Summer terms
- Take 6060 in one of your last 2 semesters (last semester would be best) as this is the closest course to a capstone course
- Everything else being equal, take courses the best you can in the order of this list
