- Scholarships will be awarded at the time of admission. A letter with the complete details will be issued.
- Both the partners must confirm acceptance and pay the required tuition deposit within 30 days of receiving their offer.
- The student receiving the spousal scholarship will not be eligible for any other financial supports from Fanshawe College, including but not limited to Fanshawe College or Donor funded Awards, Scholarships, and Bursaries.
- The primary applicant (not receiving the spousal scholarship) may still qualify for other Fanshawe College or Donor funded Awards, Scholarships, and Bursaries.
- The scholarship funds are non-transferable and will be forfeited if the student does not attend the specified term.
- Any credit balances resulting from the payment of scholarship funds will be applied towards subsequent term tuition payments. Credit balance refunds are only issued to eligible students in their final graduating term.
- In the event one or both study permit applications are denied, deposit refunds for both students will be issued less \$250 per student.
- Students may choose to change program however program changes will automatically void any or all scholarship offers.
- Both students must pay the required deposit and fees by the specified date on their most recent invoice to secure their seats.
- If the scholarship includes a payment in term 2, that payment is contingent on both the primary applicant and the spousal applicant maintaining good academic standing in term 1 of our respective programs
- The students must submit the marriage certificate in the Virtual Application System (VAS).
- To remain eligible for the Spousal Scholarship, both students must be paying international student fees. If either student receives an international fee exemption and pays domestic fees, the scholarships shall no longer apply.
