

Fanshawe College, “Apply in July 2026” Event Terms and Conditions

Fanshawe College of Applied Arts and Technology (“**Fanshawe College**”) is hosting the “Apply in July 2026” event (the “**Event**”) wherein eligible, prospective students may visit Fanshawe College’s Canada Life Village Square located at 1001 Fanshawe College Boulevard, London, Ontario N5Y 5R6 and apply in person to an Open Program (defined below) for the 2026-2027 application cycle (i.e., for programs starting in either Fall of 2026 or Winter of 2027) (the “**Application Cycle**”).

By participating in the Event, including without limitation by applying to an Open Program for the Application Cycle, you, as the prospective student, agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions of this agreement.

1. **Application Directly through Fanshawe College:** If

- (a) you are eligible (in accordance with Section 2 below),
- (b) you are applying to an Open Program (defined below) and are applying in person at the Event and finalize your application prior to the end of the Event’s Duration; and
- (c) you provide all mandatory documents and information listed in Section 3 below and all additional documents and/or information reasonably requested by Fanshawe College, and you comply with any other requirements imposed by Fanshawe College at its sole discretion,

then you may apply to an Open Program at Fanshawe College and be considered for enrolment for such Open Program, and the applicable application fee collected by Fanshawe College (up to the value of \$150 CDN) may be waived at the sole discretion of Fanshawe College (the “**Waiver**”). If awarded, (a) the Waiver is non-transferable and has no cash value; and (b) you may only receive one such Waiver per Application Cycle. For clarity, this waiver, if awarded, would only impact application fees collected by Fanshawe College, and does not impact any other fees including without limitation tuition, deposits, transcript fees, other administrative fees, or any other fees requested by any third parties.

Submitting an application for an Open Program does not guarantee acceptance of the application and/or enrolment in same. Fanshawe College’s decision to provide the Waiver, accept your application, or enrol you is final and at its sole discretion.

The “**Duration**” of the Event is: Monday, July 6 to Thursday, July 9, 2026, between the hours of 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM, Eastern Standard Time.

An “**Open Program**” refers to any regular part-time, full-time, or co-op program at Fanshawe College (including any such program at a Fanshawe College regional campuses) that have open availability for registrants (decided at the sole discretion of Fanshawe College). For example, please note that some programs, especially those that are highly competitive, may not have open availability at the time of application.

- 2. Eligibility:** In order for you to be “eligible” to apply to an Open Program through this Event, you must (a) be a domestic, Canadian applicant (International applicants should refer to <https://www.fanshawec.ca/international/applicants/apply>); (b) have not otherwise applied to any program at Fanshawe College during the Application Cycle; (c) not otherwise paid any application-related fee to OCAS or any other third party; and (d) apply to such Open Program in person at the Event.

- 3. Documentation and Information Requirements (to be provided by you):** In order to apply to any Open Program for the Application Cycle during the Event, you must bring the following documents:

- (a) Transcripts (high school and, if applicable, post-secondary) demonstrating your academic admissibility;
- (b) Your valid government-issued photo identification / proof of domestic applicant status; and
- (c) Where English is not your first language, proof of your English language proficiency (the list of requirements for such proof is available at: <https://www.fanshawec.ca/admission-finance/before-applying/admission-requirements/english-requirements>).

Upon application to an Open Program, all documents retained by Fanshawe College become the property of Fanshawe College and will not be returned; the documents are subject to Fanshawe College’s retention period. If Fanshawe College requests any document in its original form, then you shall provide such document accordingly.

In addition, you must also provide the following information:

- (a) Your email address;
- (b) Your home mailing address, including postal code;
- (c) Your phone number;
- (d) Your Ontario Education Number (OEN) and/or student number from your high school report card or transcript; and
- (e) If you previously attended college or university, your post-secondary student number(s).

For clarity, you are solely responsible for any fees associated with obtaining any documents or information to support your application to the Open Program at the Event including, without limitation, those fees associated with English-language testing.

Upon applying to the Open Program, you certify the following:

- (a) The documents and information provided is true, complete, and accurate in all respects, including my declarations as to citizenship and immigration status in Canada, secondary and post-secondary institutions attended, and that all available documents and information requested by Fanshawe College has been disclosed;
- (b) All documents and information provided in connection with your application (if any) to an Open Program is subject to verification and audit by Fanshawe College;
- (c) That you acknowledge that the requested documents and information and this agreement do not represent the entire terms of your application to the applicable Open Program, and that you acknowledge that there may be other documents or information you must submit, or other forms that must be completed with additional terms and conditions that must be agreed to as part of the registration process;
- (d) You shall provide any other documents or information to Fanshawe College upon request, including without limitation references; and
- (e) You understand that any misrepresentation on any document or information may result in cancellation of my application or enrolment status, if any.

- 4. Consent to Collection, Use, and Disclosure of Personal Information:** By participating in the Event, you consent to the collection, use, and disclosure (collectively, “**processes**”) of your personal information by Fanshawe College for the purposes of implementing, administering, and fulfilling this agreement. Specifically, the documents and information will be used to verify your qualifications and decide your eligibility for admission into the applicable Open Program to which you applied pursuant to this agreement. Upon admission and registration, if applicable, this information will form part of your student record and will be used to document your progress in an academic program. Fanshawe College will not sell or disclose this information to third parties except for the purposes of administering this agreement.

Fanshawe College processes Personal Information under the authority of the *Ontario Colleges of Applied Arts and Technology Act*, S.O. 2002, c. 8, Sched. F, and your Personal Information will be processed pursuant to the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. F.31 or another applicable privacy law.

5. Exclusion of Liability; Limitation of Liability: Fanshawe College assumes no responsibility for

- (a) documents or information that may affect a person's ability to participate in the Event, including without limitation human error, technical malfunctions of any kind, lost or delayed applications for any reason, omission, or any combination thereof, and applications that fail to fully comply with this agreement;
- (b) any injury or damage to computers or to any third party's computer related to or resulting from participating in, or downloading any material regarding the Event, applying for an Open Program, or accepting an admission into an Open Program;
- (c) any injury or damage to persons or property that may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from the person's participation in the Event, applying for an Open Program, or accepting an admission into an Open Program;
- (d) the security or privacy of information transmitted via computer networks or for breaches of privacy due to interference by third-party computer hackers or otherwise; and,
- (e) late, lost, misdirected, or unsuccessful efforts to notify you of a successful application to an Open Program.

Otherwise, you agree that the maximum, aggregate liability of Fanshawe College arising from your participation in the Event shall not exceed \$150 CDN.

6. General Terms.

- (a) Fanshawe College reserves the right to amend this agreement at any time without prior notice.
- (b) Ontario and federal law, excluding their conflict of laws rules, governs this agreement. By participating in the Event, the person hereby irrevocably consents to the jurisdiction of the Ontario courts and agrees to bring any dispute to the courts sitting in London, Ontario.
- (c) This agreement sets forth the entire understanding between the parties regarding the subject matter of this agreement.
